MAKING SHOT CLOCK GOLF A REALITY FOR REGULAR COURSES

SHOT CLOCK GOLF FORMAT

In a positive move towards addressing slow play, the European Tour took major step forward in combating the age-old problem of slow play when it implemented a shot clock format during a professional tournament.

This isn't the first time the European Tour had experimented with a shot clock format to speed up play. The GolfSixes team event was the first to have a strict 40-second limit where the tournament actually featured a big clock counting down like the NBA does above its backboards.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

It is hoped that the new format will cut round times by approximately 45 minutes, so how does the format actually work:

- The first player in every group will have 50 seconds to play any given shot, from there each subsequent player will have 40 seconds to play.
- Players will be hit with a one-shot penalty each time they take longer than their allotted time for the shot, and those penalties will be indicated by a red card against their name on the leaderboard.
- Each player will also be allowed two 'time-outs' per round, which will give them twice the time to play their shot



But will this new format be the actual cause of improvement to the game?

Or is it because of the additional media attention and greater awareness being placed on professional tournaments to manage pace, and, of course, the added accountability being forced onto professional golfers.

The new format also brings significant hurdles to professional tournaments.

When one takes into account the exhaustive manpower and resources required to succeed with shot clock play, with referee having to follow each group to keep time and enforce penalties.

Considering that golf is played by millions of people, on thousands of courses around the world, it is worth understanding the practicality of how this new format will be adopted by regular golf courses?

- Expensive management controls required by golf clubs
- Stricter mandatory penalty rules to be set in place
- Massive staff requirements and additional on-course supervision
- Inconsistency and quality of player experiences
